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#### Introduction

Sri Lanka is in a rapid phase of development. Keeping in par with this development the state health sector has implement ted many strategies in health care provision and this has helped to achieve a commendable progress in providing universal healthcare. The main health indicators of Sri Lanka are far ahead of the averages for countries at comparable levels of income. Social indicators such as life expectancy and mortality rates have been among the best in developing countries and are even comparable to some developed countries.

Western, Ayurvedic, Unani, Siddha, Acupuncture and Homeopathy systems of medicine are practiced in Sri Lanka. Of these, western medicine is catering to the needs of a vast majority of people. The public sector comprises Western and Ayurvedic systems. Sri Lanka possesses an extensive network of healthcare institutions. As such, the majority of the population has easy access to reasonable level of healthcare facilities provided by both state and private sector through the extensive network of Healthcare Institutions. A healthcare facility can be found on an average not further than 1.4Km from many homes and free Western type government health care services are available within 4.8km of a patient's home.

The Ministry of Health is the main stake holder providing stewardship to health service provision in Sri Lanka. The Government health care system is devolved to provinces to some extent. The Ministry of Health has a mandate to regulate and improve quality of care in health care services. The system is also supported by several institutions that provide other resources for health. Several training institutions provide basic, post basic and in-service-training. The public sector is financed mainly through the government tax based system.

Nevertheless, there are immense health challenges due to the recent transitions in Sri Lankan social, demographical and economic contexts. With the rapid aging of the population and the success in combating the major communicable diseases, the diseases burden has started shifting rapidly towards non-communicable diseases including mental diseases, accidents and injuries. This has raised challenges in provision of long term treatment. Nutritional status has improved but remains a serious problem among the poorer and vulnerable communities and, even on average, needs considerable improvements.

In addition, the health system itself faces several major problems in its organization, management, financing and service delivery mechanism. The issues created by the unfinished agenda of devolution, lack of an efficient management information system and lack of a results-based performance appraisal mechanism pose significant challenges to management. The health expenditure in government sector has gone up every year and new units and technologies are being introduced at present at a very high cost to improve overall quality of healthcare.

Additionally, there are vulnerable, neglected and marginalized population groups within the districts such as estate sector communities and urban slum dwellers. It is very difficult to appoint and retain medical, nursing and other human resources in those specific areas due to unavailability of basic requirements such as quarters, transport, communication etc. Therefore, average health situation related to the whole country does not reflect the social and geographical disparities that exist between district and provinces and also between different groups of communities.

As the policy of the government at present is to provide total health care free of charge at all points of delivery, the Ministry of Health need to prioritize health needs of the people and to strengthen evidence based planning in order to utilize available resources optimally. To decrease the resource gap and to increase the equity of service provision, there is significant pressure to make the best use of the limited financial resources available and rationalize logistics and administration, in order to optimize resource utilization. These challenges require review and effective responses to overcome them.

To achieve these objectives of optimal resource utilization and enhanced equitable resource distribution for equitable healthcare service provision, it is essential to identify the existing situation of resource distribution and performance of health system of the country along with their regional disparities.

Health Information Unit of Management Development and Planning Unit of Ministry of Health have conducted this health facility survey in 2014/2015.

The objectives of the facility survey were:

- 1. To describe available facilities in the health care institutions
- 2. To facilitate evidence based planning

Methodology used in the facility survey

As the initial step, survey formats were designed with the participation of all the relevant and key stakeholders in the regional and national health settings. Consultative meetings were held and the survey formats were refined and finalized. All forms for institutions up to Base Hospital level were developed by the planning unit and PMCU was developed by Director Organization DeDevelopmentthe survey form for the quarters was developed by Director Policy planning and development. The survey formats were distributed to institutions through electronic and postal means. Additionally, secondary data from Department of Census and Statistics, Family Health Bureau, Epidemiology Unit and specialized disease control campaigns were also collected. Finally, all the collected information was compiled with suitable indicators to formulate the facility survey and this publication is a result of this process.

Existing needs and their regional disparities that are identified through this exercise can be used as the basis for equitable resource allocation and evidence based planning. It will be of immense help as a tool for performance evaluation and comparison of performances between regions. These profiles can be used as a baseline for the future performance evaluations and future trend analysis as well.






#### Distribution of Available Beds among Health Care Institutions






#### Average Population per PHM and PHI area




Proportion of LSCS out of total deliveries



Proportion of Major Surgeries out of total Surgeries




Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from Allocation to Medical Supplies



#### Comparison of Dengue, Tuberculosis and Leptospirosis Incidence in Provinces







#### Comparison of Socio-economic Indicators with National Value




#### Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators






#### Comparison of Significant Communicable Diseases with National Values



#### Distribution of Available Beds among Health Care Institutions






#### Average Population per PHM and PHI area




#### Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from Allocation to Medical Supplies



Proportion of LSCS out of total deliveries




Proportion of Major Surgeries out of total Surgeries










#### Comparison of Socio-economic Indicators with National Value




#### Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators






#### Comparison of Significant Communicable Diseases with National Values



#### Distribution of Available Beds among Health Care Institutions




#### Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from Allocation to Medical Supplies




Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators






Comparison of Significant Communicable Diseases with National Values




#### Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators








Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators






Comparison of Significant Communicable Diseases with National Values








Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators








#### Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators






Proportion of LSCS out of total deliveries



Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from llocation to Medical Supplies









Comparison of Maternal and Child Health related indicators


Proportion of LSCS out of total deliveries



Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from Allocation to Medical Supplies







# Proportion of Value of Local Purchases from Allocation to Medical Supplies
